What Does MSCC Certification Mean?

MSCC Certified Technicians are the best-trained and experienced technicians in the industry. It's your guarantee that you're getting the top professionals in their specific trade. It also means these technicians have completed a stringent, multi-year apprenticeship program, achieved journeyman status and passed a comprehensive MSCC Certification exam in their area(s) of expertise. MSCC Certified Technicians are the best, most efficient, highly skilled workers available.

How To Become An MSCC Certified Technician

Application & Testing Process

To become a MSCC Certified Technician you must complete and submit the application form, provide the required documentation, apply for a username and password to access the online test, write the online test within 30 days of receiving your username and password, pass the test with a minimum 70%. The test is taken online and consists of 35-40 questions. The test must be completed within 2 hours. Your mark will be provided immediately upon completion of the test and notification of your mark will also be sent immediately to the MSCC Certification Committee. A certificate and wallet sized certification card will be provided to you upon successful completion of the process. Only employees of MSCC members can apply. Cost to write each test is \$75.00 + HST Cdn.

Preparation

The exam is based on several areas specific to your trade which are listed below. To prepare, all answers are available from your apprenticeship texts and you will have access to sample examination questions on the MSCC website.

The MSCC Certified Technician's program enables MSCC members to receive industry recognition for their training and technical skills in the following trades.

Required Documentation & Commitment

To sit for the MSCC Certified Technician exam you must :

- a) Training – provide a qualified journeyman license
- b) Experience – supply written endorsement from your employer
- c) Written test – write the online test in your specific area(s) of expertise
- d) Commitment – sign and submit annual commitment form along with proof of education
- e) Education – maintain proof of ongoing education through a minimum one course per year

Ongoing Requirements

Each year you must provide proof of the training program(s) you attended and include them with the signed commitment form you will receive which states you remain compliant with the certification criteria. Annual dues are \$25.00 plus HST which included a new photo ID card.
